Africa made the following observation about the impact made by the School of Practical Ministry......



Teaching the WORD to the World



Training the next generation of Pastors and Leaders in developing nations



What began as a request from a missionary in Kenya to come train a small group of pastors in 2009, has grown into an International Program. To date, we have had the joy and privilege of training over 1,400 men and women from seven African nations. In addition, we have invitations to Liberia, Madagascar, India and Cote d'Ivoire to train pastors and church leaders.

These pastors and leaders have little to no formal training and little hope of ever receiving any, so this is an opportunity they only dream of. SOPM class sizes are limited to 80 - 90 students per location, yet there are always waiting lists of pastors who desire this basic, yet life giving training.

The training Evangel offers these pastors and leaders is our **School of Practical Ministry** (SOPM) which is taught over an intensive 2 week time frame. (The SOPM material is taken from curriculum developed by the founder of Evangel Seminary, Dr. Robert Reichard).

The School of Practical Ministry provides solid Biblical training through 7 Learning Modules and 3 Learning Projects. Upon successful completion, students receive a certificate that is well earned.

This equipping provides a solid Biblical foundation they can build on to more accurately preach and teach the Word of God. In addition, they have renewed vison for reaching their communities in ways that reflect the heart and love of Christ.

15USTAINABLE

The School of Practical Ministry is uniquely structured to provide foundational Biblical training in a short period of time. It is also designed to be handed off to native instructors so they can continue training without our physical presence.

Over the course of 2 consecutive years, Evangel goes to a nation once a year to train pastors and leaders. During that time we also train native instructors who will become certified through Evangel. In turn, they will continue the training starting in the 3rd year and beyond.

These instructors remain accountable to Evangel and they only use materials provided by E.T.S. for the training. They regularly supply feedback and reports on the classes they are teaching.

In this way we can keep our finger on the pulse of the SOPM program while continuing to explore new avenues for training in other developing nations.

One question we often receive is; "How much do you charge to provide this training?" The simple answer is: "We do not charge pastors and leaders a fee for taking the School of Practical Ministry."

While there is clearly a "cost" associated with the materials, travel, accommodations and the instruction time, these students simply do not have the financial resources to pay us, no matter how valuable it is to them.

All of the funding for this international training is raised through the kind and gracious gifts of friends and partners here in the U.S. (See back panel for information on how you can partner with Evangel in this international training ministry.)

These men and women are often overwhelmed that people they do not know would invest in them. They carry a deep sense of responsibility to be as fruitful as possible because of this tangible demonstration of love towards them and the ministry they are in.
